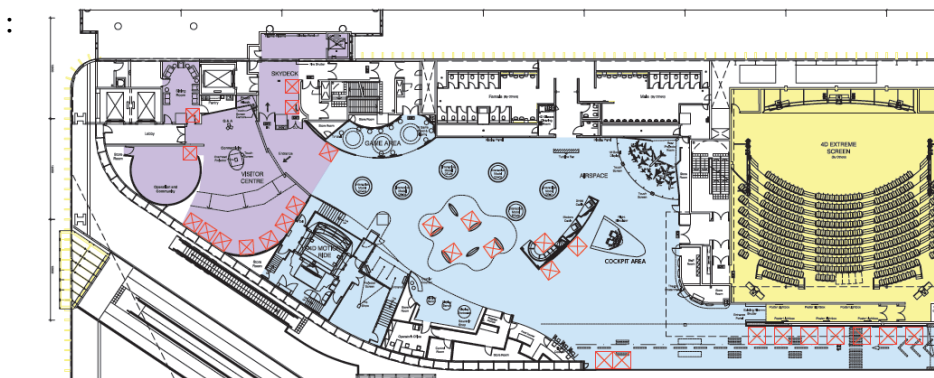
Island Scouts ☆ Hurtling Sky to Save the Future

Instructions to Participants



- Name of Activity : Island Scouts ☆ Hurtling Sky to Save the Future
- Date : 27 December 2010 (Monday)
- Time : 6 pm to 10:30 pm
- Venue : Aviation Discovery Centre, Hong Kong International Airport Terminal 2
- Theme : Aerospace, Environmental Protection and Future
- Aim : To arouse participating scouts' interest in exploring the future development of aerospace and to inspire them to think deep about the meaning and significance of environmental protection. (please refer to the annex for the story)
- Grouping : To facilitate arrangement of activities, will put participants into three activity groups as follows:
 Group 1: Sub-camp H + Silver Jubilee District
 Group 2: Sub-camp K + 175th HKG
 Group 3: Sub-camp I and Sub-camp R (some participants will be evenly assigned to Group 1 and Group 2)
- Activity : Activities will take place in three sectors as follows:
 Sector A: 4D Extreme Screen and performances
 Sector B: Exhibition and Game Booths
 Sector C: Game Booths and the Airport's Observation Deck

- Activity Flow : The activities in each sector revolve around one of three themes – aerospace, environmental protection and future. The groups will take turns to take part in the activities in the sectors, with each group staying in one sector for 50 minutes. The activity flow is as follows:
Group 1: Sector A → Sector C → Sector B
Group 2: Sector C → Sector B → Sector A
Group 3: Sector B → Sector A → Sector C

- Transport Arrangement : A fleet of 14 coaches will take participants to Hong Kong International Airport after dinner on 27 December 2010. After the event, we will arrival the campsite around 10:30 p.m.
- Dinner Time : 5:30 pm to 6 pm, 27 December 2010
- Camp Leaving Arrangement : HKIR Solomon Sub-camp office will complete camp-leaving formalities for all participants in advance.
- The Best Disguise Competition** : **Participants are encouraged to use their imagination and make-up skills and disguise themselves either as astronauts or as creatures from the future. The winner will earn the title of Future Warrior and get an extra prize.**
- Others :
 - Given the number of participants and a tight schedule, participants should follow strictly the staffs' instructions so that everything can proceed smoothly. They should go about the various activities as a group in an orderly manner.
 - Participants should bring their own **flashlights and cameras**, but should not bring along expensive items. They should also bring along **enough warm clothing**.
