Badges you need to buy at scout shop are: 香港章、港島地域章、會員章 &隊色 (if you know which patrol your child belongs); 旅巾、灣仔區章 and 二二九旅帶 are to be presented to new scouts at oath taking. You may also buy《童軍訓練綱要》及「童軍紀錄冊」Other optional items: 童軍繩、 Silva-type compass (for orienteering and map reading), 營火袍,童軍刀, 童軍 V 領長袖毛衣。
